Ready for games 'under the lights'



Night games can now be played on the north softball field at Osmond Ball Park. Fund-raising and countless hours of donated materials, time, labor and equipment brought the project to fruition in recent weeks. In the accompanying photo, a pole is set in right center field. Five other poles were put in place to illuminate the field. The estimated cost in cash outlay is \$18,163. In addition, there was an undisclosed amount in the poles and brackets by Osmond native Terry McClain of Valmont Industries. Large contributions in the project included Thomsen's Corner, \$1,000; American Broadband (HunTel), \$1,500 and trenching; Osmond Community Club, \$3,000; Hartland Concrete and West-Hodson Lumber & Concrete, 10 yards concrete each; Northeast Nebraska Public Power District, drilling holes; Lind-Gubbels, Inc., boom truck use and staff labor; City of Osmond, equipment and staff. The City of Osmond made its first contribution from the KENO fund toward community improvement to assist with the light project. The project was coordinated by Osmond Park Board members.
